



Out and about





A collection of poetry reflecting on our shared emotions during the Covid lockdowns of 2020.






Fiction Highlights



Hazel Gaydon


Gran teaches Zac and Zara what is going on inside their bodies and how they can choose to stay healthy and feel well.

Helen Garraway


Sentinals Banished is the fifth book in the saga of Remargaren, a vibrant, ancient world of high fantasy suffused with magic and adventure.

Melissa Moschitto



R.I. Maddams



The trials and tribulations of a young woman entering the world of wealth, opulence, and fashion.




Leaping Beauty

In a kingdom that has lost its way, at a time when there are few bright things left to stop the carriage for, a young princess jumps out of a window and blazes an unexpected trail.


